

Cambridgeshire County Council, (Various Roads, Steeple Morden), (Speed Limits) (Consolidation), Order 202-

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of this Order will be to;

To introduce a 20mph speed limit on the whole length of Cheney Close, Church Street, Jubilee End, Jubilee Way and Russell Close and on Cheyney Street from its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for 348 metres, on Hay Street from its junction with Cheyney Street in a northerly direction for 197m and on Station Road from its junction with Church Street in a southerly direction for 72m.

For administrative purposes the following Orders will be revoked, though their effects, as amended by the proposed, shall be consolidated into this Order:

- The County of Cambridgeshire (40mph speed limit) (No.2) Order 1996
- Cambridgeshire County Council (40mph speed limit) (No.3) Order 2005
- Cambridgeshire County Council (30mph limit) (Various Streets, Steeple Morden) Order 2014
- Cambridgeshire County Council (North Brook End and Station Road, Steeple Morden) (40mph speed limit) Order 2022
- Cambridgeshire County Council (Trap Road, Steeple Morden) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2024
